CRITICAL ITEMS							
OPERATORS - Failure to employ an appropriately certified operator.							
<b>PERMIT VERIFICATION</b> - Construction of an unpermitted facility; violation of construction permit so as to seriously threaten the effectiveness of the treatment works.							
<b>PERMIT VERIFICATION</b> - Construction of unpermitted modifications to a facility; construction of an unpermitted extension of collection system.							
FENCING – Lack of 6' high woven wire fence in residential areas.							
LINERS & SEALS - Lack of a proper seal in the lagoon dikes and/or bottom, allowing visible seepage from the lagoon.							
<b>BYPASSES AND/OR SSOs</b> - Failure to orally report all dry or wet weather bypasses and/or SSOs within twenty-four hours and/or failure to file a written report within five days.							
BYPASSES AND/OR SSOs - Failure to correct previously reported bypasses and/or SSOs in a timely manner.							
WATER REUSE – All water reuse sites must be properly permitted (Five year permits) with no construction defects							
WATER REUSE – Reuse water may not be applied at rates that create runoff or pooling on the site							
WATER REUSE – All equipment must be maintained in good working order and meet the minimum requirements.							
WATER REUSE – All reuse sites must have a 100 foot buffer from the spray application area to the property boundary							
<b>POTABLE WATER</b> - Allowing the physical connection or piping arrangement between the potable water systems and a system of unknown or questionable quality.
